- That the applicant furnish to the city clerk proof that the vehicle is currently insured

RECOMMENDATION(S):
 to consider increasing the number of vehicles Modified Mobile can operate under their current paratransit permit.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:
 On May 1, 2018 the Hot Springs Board of Directors passed Resolution No. 9257 approving a paratransit permit for Modified Mobile, LLC that allowed the licensing of one vehicle. Mr. Smith desires to increase his fleet and requests approval of up to five vehicles to be licensed under paratransit permit #43.
 HSC 13-1-14. - Vehicle licenses. (6) Additional licenses. Any permit holder may apply for authorization to license additional vehicles in excess of the number authorized in his/her permit by submitting an application for additional vehicles to the administrative authority. Said application shall state the permit holder's name and permit number, the number of additional vehicles desired and information illustrating the need for said additional vehicles. The application shall be reviewed in the same manner as a new permit application. Provided, however, that formal notice of the public hearing and to other providers, as required by section 13-1-12, shall not be required for additional license applications. The Transportation Advisory Committee is conducting a public hearing on December 1, 2022 to review the request pursuant to the Transportation Code and recommend that the requested increase in licenses under Paratransit Permit # 43 be approved or denied.

WHEREAS, Modified Mobile, LLC has made an application to operate one vehicle; and that


WHEREAS, the Transportation Advisory Committee conducted a public hearing on April 11, 2018, and reviewed the application pursuant to the Transportation Code; and that
