

ORDINANCE NO. 6321

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 5406 THAT ESTABLISHED THE FIRE SERVICE FEE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY THE HOT SPRINGS FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 5406, approved December 19, 2005, authorized the collection of fees by the Hot Springs Fire Department for first responder activities associated with emergency medical services from the owner/operator or responsible party who caused or contributed to the accident/incident, and

WHEREAS, the application of such fees has resulted in a small amount of such fees being collected with increasingly negative impressions of and relations between the Fire Department and City residents.

WHEREAS, City staff propose that it is in the best interests of the City to eliminate such fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of Hot Springs, Arkansas, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 5406 be repealed in its entirety.


SECTION 2: That Sections 1 and 3 of Ordinance No. 4338 that were amended by Ordinance No. 5406 be restored to their original language as adopted on September 7, 1993.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be codified in the Hot Springs Code of Ordinances and the sections may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention.
