

ORDINANCE NO. 6331

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING WATER AND WASTEWATER STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE CITY OF HOT SPRINGS, ARKANSAS MUNICIPAL UTILITY SYSTEM, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 5665 adopted Water and Wastewater Engineering and Construction Standards and Specifications for the Hot springs Municipal Utilities System on August 5, 2008; and that

WHEREAS, said standards and specifications have been revised and approved by the Arkansas Department of Health Engineering Section; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Hot Springs for the Board of Directors to adopt said updated standards and specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of Hot Springs, Arkansas, as follows:

SECTION 1. Adoption. That the attached Water and Wastewater Standards and Specifications are hereby adopted by reference as though set out herein word for word. Said Standards and Specifications shall be known and cited as the Hot Springs Water and Wastewater Standards and Specifications.

SECTION 2. Penalty. The penalty for violation of this Code shall, upon conviction in a court of competent jurisdiction, be such fines and penalties as established by the general penalties clause for the Hot Springs Code of Ordinances as may now or hereafter be enacted by the Hot Springs Board of Directors.

SECTION 3. Severability. Should any part of these regulations be judged invalid by a court of law having jurisdiction, all other parts shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Repealer. Ordinance No. 5665 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be June 5, 2020.

SECTION 6. Codification. This Ordinance shall be codified in the Code of Ordinances, and the sections may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention.
