

ORDINANCE NO. 6367

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4002 OF 1989 PERTAINING TO THE HOT SPRINGS ADVERTISING AND PROMOTION COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, The Arkansas General Assembly adopted Act 560 of 2019 amending certain provisions of Arkansas Code Annotated § 26-75-602; and that

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4002 should be amended so that it conforms with the language in Act 560 and is in accord with A.C.A. § 26-75-602(c)(1) and (2).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the City of Hot Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1: That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 4002, as amended, is hereby amended by replacing Section 1 (A) and (B) with the following language:


Section 1: (A) A tax of three percent (3%) *is hereby* levied on the gross receipts or gross proceeds from renting, leasing, or otherwise furnishing hotel, motel, house, cabin, bed and breakfast, campground, condominium, or other similar rental accommodations for sleeping, meeting, or party room facilities for profit in such city or town, but such accommodations shall not include the rental or lease of such accommodations for periods of thirty (30) days or more; and

(B) A tax of three percent (3%) is hereby levied on the portion of the gross receipts or gross proceeds received by restaurants, cafes, cafeterias, delicatessens, drive-in restaurants, carry-out restaurants, food trucks, concession stands, convenience stores, grocery store-restaurants, or similar businesses as shall be defined in the levying ordinance from the sale of prepared food and beverages for on-premises or off-premises consumption, but such tax shall not apply to such gross receipts or gross proceeds of organizations qualified under [26 U.S.C. § 501\(c\)\(3\)](#);

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be codified in the Hot Springs Code of Ordinances and the sections may be re-numbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention.




