

ORDINANCE NO. 6394

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 6069, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO INOPERABLE VEHICLES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

*WHEREAS*, Hot Springs Code for inoperable vehicles should be amended to eliminate verbiage limiting applicability only to motorized vehicles;

*NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED* by the Board of Directors of the City of Hot Springs, Arkansas, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That Ordinance 6069, as amended by Ordinance No. 6295, is hereby further amended by the following:

- a. That the word “motor” is removed from Hot Springs Code Title 17, Article IV Title which now shall be entitled *Inoperable Vehicles Code*.
- b. Section 17-2-4 is hereby amended to define *Inoperable vehicle* as Any vehicle not in proper condition to be legally operated on the streets of Hot Springs; or that does not have a current valid registration and/or license plate, when required; or if motorized and not capable of being self-propelled. For purposes herein, the term vehicle shall include any self-propelled vehicle, boat, camper, or trailer, used for the transportation of people or cargo.
- c. That the word “motor” shall be removed from Hot Springs Code Title 17, Article IV, Section 17-2-15 caption and text which shall now read:

“17-2-15. **Inoperable Vehicles Unlawful.** It shall be unlawful for any person to keep, maintain, or store inoperable vehicles, as defined in Article I, upon public or private property within the City of Hot Springs.
- d. That the word “motor” shall be removed from Section 17-2-15.3(a), (b), and (c).
- e. That Hot Springs Code tables of contents be amended to reflect these changes.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall be codified in the Code of Ordinances and the sections may be re-numbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention.
